PHYSICAL

All campers must have a physical to participate in camp. You can get your own physical with your own doctor. Also, in order to comply with the School Immunization Act, all child care facilities, including camps, must have children's immunizations recorded on the Health Department's Certification of Immunization. Please take the yellow Certification of Immunization and have it completed by your doctor or obtain a copy from the school nurse. If your child is coming from out of state, the parent/guardian may sign the personal exemption section if your child is not "up to date" for Colorado standards.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Please include a copy of your medical insurance cards along with your camper's application. If you do not have a medical card, but have insurance, please list the company, primary holder's name and policy number on the health form portion of this application.

All registrants are covered by excess camper medical insurance and subject to the limits thereof. **Individual insurance is primary.**

WHAT NOT TO BRING!
